As there were insufficient committee members attending to form a quorum, an informal discussion followed:

**Minutes from previous meeting** should be amended to state that the height of the hedge should be 1.2 rather than 1.5m.

Size of the committee could be increased to 11 members, rather that 9 as it is currently.

**Play Area.** The application for a grant of \$4,400 from the Bulgana wind farm has been successful for the purchase of the Xylophone and McKenzies transport have said that they could deliver it for about \$345, leaving only around \$290 to be funded by the Friends. Janelle has informed Tony Dark of this and asked what we need to do to start some progress on this project.

**Signage in the Gardens.** There has been no further action from Tina Baker on proposed signage.

**Proposed pedestrian crossing** in Kings Avenue will reduce the parking spaces in that area by about 10. This will be detrimental to both the gardens and the Shire Café.
