- Critical upgrades are required to the deteriorated guard railings and barriers for traffic management and safety, alongside applying a bitumen seal to the gravel car park
- Outcomes include improving the safe access and wellbeing of locals and visitors alike to this iconic location in Stawell

Known as Kobram to our First Nations people and recognised as a traditional area for corroboree, Big Hill is a vantage point for locals and visitors to obtain grand and sweeping views of the Grampians (Gariwerd) mountain range against the town of Stawell and surrounding lakes and districts.
