- The Heath Street bridge will reduce traffic congestion and enable visitors to more safely access Halls Gap village centre at their leisure
- Improved pedestrian connections to the village centre support the redevelopment of underutilised commercial land along Heath Street
- This will build capacity to cater for increased visitor numbers as the GPT gains in popularity and spur greater visitor spend in a key tourist location in the broader Wimmera Southern Mallee region

The Heath Street Bridge will transform access to Halls Gap, the village at the heart of the Grampians (Gariwerd) National Park. With 1.7M visitors to the Grampians region each year, and the base of the new Grampians Peaks Trail, this critical infrastructure will unlock commercial opportunity and improve accessibility to this iconic natural environment
