Final Seal Program			When a road is upgraded with a new seal, a final seal coat should be applied 12 months after the initial seal has been undertaken. This gives the road seal its full lifespan	\$348,000
Footpath Program			This program constructs new footpaths to high use areas that currently don't have a constructed path and renews existing footpaths that are above intervention level or substandard.	\$83,000

Resheeting Program			Resheeting is a standard process to renew the gravel payment of existing gravel roads.
